

Privacy policy

Effective 10 September 2026

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This policy explains what personal data Noisypeak Sàrl collects when you use myfast.ch, why we collect it, who else sees it and what you can ask us to do with it. It applies to this website and to the Noisypeak Payout service your channel runs on.

1. Who is responsible for your data

The controller is Noisypeak Sàrl, EPFL Innovation Park, Bâtiment D, CH-1015 Lausanne, Switzerland, registered under CHE-270.718.196.

We have not appointed a data protection officer. Our processing is small in scale, it does not involve monitoring people systematically and it handles no sensitive data, so one is not required. Privacy questions go to the address above.

2. What this site collects

- **Your channel draft.** Name, genres, content rating, language, colours, fonts, logo and the library you picked. Held in your browser's local storage on your own device. It is not sent to us and we cannot read it. Clearing your browser data deletes it.
- **Your email address,** and a password you choose, but only from the moment you create an account. Both go straight to Payout; see section 6.
- **Nothing else.** No analytics service, no advertising tag and no tracking pixel runs on this site. How far you got in the setup is remembered in your own browser, for you, and is sent nowhere.
- **Server logs.** IP address, browser, page requested and the time, written automatically by the server that delivers this site.

We do not ask for and do not want any special category data: nothing about health, beliefs, politics or biometrics.

3. Why we use it, and on what legal basis

- **To run the setup you started.** Necessary to take steps at your request before a contract, Article 6(1)(b) GDPR and the corresponding Swiss provision.
- **To create your account and channel in Payout.** Performance of the contract, Article 6(1)(b).
- **To keep the site running and to see that it is not being attacked.** Our legitimate interest in a service that works, Article 6(1)(f). This rests on the server logs in section 2 and on nothing else.
- **To keep the service secure and to meet legal obligations.** Articles 6(1)(f) and 6(1)(c).

4. Cookies and similar technologies

This site sets **no** advertising, analytics or profiling cookies, so there is no consent banner to click. What it does use is local storage on your own device, to remember your channel draft between visits. That is shared with nobody.

Payout sets a session cookie once you sign in there. It is technically required to keep you signed in, which is why it does not need consent.

If an analytics or advertising tag is ever added, this section and section 5 are rewritten and a real consent banner is put up before it goes live.

5. Analytics

We use no analytics service at all. No third party counts your visit, no identifier is set to recognise you again, and nothing about what you looked at leaves this site. The only record of your visit is the server log described in section 2.

6. What is sent to Payout, and when

Nothing leaves this site until you press launch. At that point we send to Payout: the channel name, description and short description, the genres, the content rating, the language and time zone, the brand kit (two fonts, two colours and the logo), the content library you chose, and the email address you registered with.

Payout is operated by the same company, Noisypeak Sàrl, and Payout has no separate privacy policy of its own: this one covers what happens there too. If a separate policy is published later, it will be linked here and you will be told before it applies to you.

7. Who else sees your data

- **Hosting.** Nobody. The site and Payout run on our own servers, in our own data centre, so no hosting company handles anything of yours on the way.
- **Payments.** Handled inside Payout by Stripe, which takes the card details directly. This site never sees a card number and has no payment fields anywhere.
- **Authorities,** where the law requires it.

Nothing is sold, rented or handed to an advertising network. There is no advertising network involved in this site at all.

8. Where your data is kept, and transfers abroad

Your account and channel data sit on our own servers, in our own data centre. They are not parked with a hosting company and not spread across somebody else's cloud.

The one exception is payment. Stripe takes the card details on its own systems, under its own terms, and that is the only part of this that leaves our machines. Where those systems sit outside Europe, Stripe's data terms rely on the European Commission's standard contractual clauses. You may ask us for a copy of them.

9. How long we keep it

- **Your channel draft** stays in your browser until you delete it or clear your browser data. We hold no copy.
- **Server logs:** kept for 90 days, then deleted.
- **Account and channel data** live in Payout for as long as your account exists. When an account is closed, everything in it, your media included, is deleted 30 days later. Take a copy of anything you want to keep before that.

10. Security

The site is served over an encrypted connection, from our own domain, with the fonts and the video served from it as well, so no third party learns what you looked at. Your channel draft never leaves your browser, which means there is no copy of it for us to lose. Access to any system holding customer data is restricted to the people who need it, and because the machines are our own, no outside provider's staff can reach them either. We hold no certification and claim none: what is written here is what is done.

11. Marketing

We never send marketing email. The only email you get from us concerns your own account or your own channel: a confirmation, a receipt, a security notice, or a change to this policy. There is no newsletter, nothing to unsubscribe from, and we do not record whether you opened anything we sent.

12. Your rights

Under the Swiss Federal Act on Data Protection and, where it applies, the GDPR, you may ask us to:

- confirm whether we process data about you, and give you a copy of it;
- correct anything inaccurate;
- delete it;
- restrict how we use it;
- hand it over in a portable format, or send it to another provider;
- stop processing that rests on legitimate interest, by objecting;
- withdraw a consent you gave, without affecting what was done before.

Write to the address in section 1. We answer within 30 days, and we do not charge for it.

13. If you are not satisfied

You may complain to the Swiss Federal Data Protection and Information Commissioner in Bern, or, if you are in the EU or the UK, to the supervisory authority where you live.

14. Children

This service is sold to businesses and is not directed at children. We do not knowingly collect data from anyone under 16. If you believe a child has given us data, write to us and we will delete it.

15. Automated decisions

We make no decision about you by automated means alone, and we do not profile you. The text the site drafts for your channel description is generated from what you typed, and it decides nothing about you.

16. If you are in California or another US state

The service is sold to businesses, not to consumers, and it is not aimed at households. If you deal with us from California, or from another US state with a privacy law of its own, this is where you stand.

What we collect is what section 2 lists: an identifier, in the form of your email address; commercial information, in the form of the channel you set up and what you pay for it in Payout; and internet activity, in the form of server logs. We collect no sensitive personal information as those laws define it, and we make no inferences about you.

We do not sell personal information and we do not share it for cross-context behavioural advertising. We never have. To ask what we hold, to have it corrected, or to have it deleted, write to the address in section 1. Asking costs you nothing and changes nothing about the service you get.

17. Changes to this policy

If we change anything material we will say so on this page and move the date at the top. If you have an account, we also tell you by email before the change takes effect.
